### **Book Fair**




Online orders during and after your book fair will always earn 30% of net sales in 'Ave Dollars' (short for Ave Maria Dollars) which can then be used to purchase books for your organization. In other words, your organization can earn Ave Dollars all year long!

**During your book fair, we offer free shipping** for any on-line orders shipped to the organization. The books generally arrive within 2 weeks of the fair closing.

Alternatively, books can be delivered to a shopper's home. In these cases, the shipping will not be free, but your organization will still earn 30% in Ave Dollars.






