Please see the below snippet recapping the Lumen Christi Banquet. Dr. Donnelly, principal at Central, did this nice write-up and was kind enough to let me share it with you all!

I have some wonderful news that I am very happy to share with you today. On February I, the Lumen Christi Banquet to celebrate and support our Great Falls Catholic Schools was, as expected, a great evening of faith, fellowship, and fun. But we also received a special message at Lumen Christi from Bishop Jeffrey Fleming, and an incredibly important one for our Catholic schools and families: Bishop Fleming, Father Doug Krings of Holy Spirit Parish, and Father Alphonsus Enelichi of Our Lady of Lourdes Parish have agreed that a single K-12 campus with a new school for Great Falls Catholic Schools is now the official vision for our future. Details will be shared in due time – as Bishop Fleming said in his address to the Lumen Christi audience, "stay tuned" – but for now, let us all give thanks that this turning point in the history of Catholic education in Great Falls and north central Montana has begun. Pope Francis has declared 2025 the year of the Jubilee of Hope, and Bishop Fleming's vision for our schools has certainly brought us all great hope for 2025 and beyond.
